416	10-22-90	Adopting a qualified employee benefit plan pursuant Internal Revenue Code § 125, placing all current benefit programs under administration of the new plan, and changing all references to “hospitalization insurance” or “employment benefits” in village ordinances to the new qualified employment benefit plan.

432	5-28-96	An ordinance to provide for the issuance and sale of revenue bonds of equal standing with the revenue bonds now outstanding to pay the cost of the acquisition and construction of additions, improvements and extensions to the water supply and sewage disposal system of the Village of Kalkaska; to prescribe the form of the bonds; to provide for the collection of revenues from the system sufficient for the purpose of paying the costs of operation and maintenance of the system and to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds; to provide an adequate reserve fund for the bonds; to provide for the segregation and distribution of the revenues; to provide for the rights of the holders of the bonds in enforcement thereof; and to provide for other matters relating to the system and the bonds.
434	11-24-97	An ordinance to provide for the issuance and sale of revenue refunding bonds to pay part of the cost of refunding the village's water supply and sewage disposal system revenue bonds, Series 1975 and to prescribe the form of the refunding bonds; to provide for the collection of revenues from the system sufficient for the purpose of paying the costs of operation and maintenance of the system and to pay the principal of and interest on the refunding bonds and certain outstanding bonds of equal standing of the system; to provide an adequate reserve fund for the refunding bonds and outstanding bonds of the system; to provide for the segregation and distribution of the revenues; to provide for the rights of the holders of the refunding bonds and outstanding bonds of the system in enforcement thereof; to provide for other matters relating to the system and the refunding bonds and outstanding bonds of the system; and to restate and amend Ordinance No. A-26 of the Village.
